EIGHTH NATIONAL CONGRESS OF COLLEGE STUDENTS AND SESOND NATIONAL CAMPUS ADVISERS SEMINAR

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

- 1. In line with the government's emphasis on youth involvement in nation-building, the Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports and the Manila YMCA will jointly hold the Eighth National Congress of College Students at the Senior Mess, Teachers Camp, Baguio City on December 19-23, 1982.
- 2. The Third National Campus Advisers Seminar will be held simultaneously with the Congress on December 19-23, 1982 at Teachers Camp in Baguio City.
- The theme of the Congress is "Youth and the KKK: A Viable Partnership" and for the Advisers Seminar is "Working Together for Effective Campus Organizations" with the following sub-topics:
 - a. Variables Essential to Campus Organizations
 - b. Student Needs and Interests Relevant to Organizations
 - c. Use of Matrix in Student Activities
- 4. The Congress intends to attain the following objectives:
 - a. To make the youth understand the development of human resources and the enhancement of human environment as a basis for national development;
 - b. To provide opportunities for actual participation in national development activities; and
 - c. To enable the youth to know and understand by actual practice the intricate processes of legislation and its importance to national progress.

- The Congress is open to college students taking degree courses, preferably those with experience in youth leadership training projects/activities. A student-delegate should be at least a second year college student and should be recommended by a school, college or university head. The advisers seminar is open to faculty members involved in campus organization projects/activities.
- 6. All schools, colleges and universities are urged to participate in the Congress. Heads of schools, colleges and universities are authorized to recommend not more than ten (10) selected students from each institution to attend the Congress and not more than two (2) for the Advisers Seminar. Deadline for the submission of applications of student-delegates and for advisers is October 30 for provincial delegates and November 30 for Metro Manila delegates. Inclosed are copies of the application forms for the Congress and for the advisers seminar.
- Congress and advisers fees of \$350.00 which covers accommodations, transportation for Manila-Baguio-Manila, meals, insurance, materials, certificate, and other expenses that may be incurred in connection with attendance thereto shall be borne by the school, college, or university represented therein or by any private organization. In this connection, attention is invited to paragraph 3 of MEC Order No. 17, s. 1982 requiring the submission by the sponsor of a post-audit report of the collections and disbursements which should be strictly complied with.
- 8. A certificate of attendance signed by the Chairman of the College Work Committee, the President, Executive Secretary of the YMCA of Manila, and the Executive of the congress will be given to each participant.
- 9. Student-delegates and advisers shall submit reports on their participation in the Congress and Advisers Seminar which shall include a summary of the discussions taken up, prescribed materials and handouts, as well as their recommendations.
