1982 FISH CONSERVATION WEEK CELEBRATION

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Schools Superintendents, State and Universities  
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities  
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities  
Vocational Schools Superintendents/Administrators

1. In accordance with Proclamation No. 176, dated October 21, 1963, Fish Conservation Week will be observed this year on October 18-23, the theme of which is "Kasaganaan sa Karagatan, Kabuhayan ng Bayan."
2. The objective of the celebration is to create an awareness among the youth of the vital importance of fisheries and aquatic resources in the country's social and economic well-being.
3. The Week may be celebrated with appropriate activities, either in or outside the classroom. Below are suggested activities for the occasion:
  - a. Integrating the teaching of fishery in the school subjects particularly in Science, Social Studies, Homemaking Arts, Communication Arts and Mathematics.
  - b. Setting up an exhibit of pictures or actual fish and other marine products as well as fishing gears in classroom or in a strategic place in the school.
  - c. Visiting and conducting lecture-tours of fish-ponds, fish markets, fishing villages, and fishery projects.

4. Technical men from the Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources will visit some schools and will conduct lectures and open forum with the students during the Week.

5. Parents and other lay members of the community may be invited to observe and listen to, as well as participate in, the activities scheduled by the school during the celebration of the Week.

6. It is desired that this announcement be given wide publicity in the schools.
