LIVE-IN WORKSHOP OF THE PHILIPPINE GUIDANCE AND PERSONNEL ASSOCIATION

- 1. The Philippine Guidance and Personnel Association, Inc. (PGPA), a national organization of guidance counselors, with the cooperation of the Don Mariano Marcos Memorial State University (DMMMSU) at Bacnotan, La Union, the Fund for Assistance to Private Education, the Baguio-Benguet Chapter of the PGPA, and the UP Department of Counselor Education, will hold a live-in workshop at the DMMMSU on October 13-16, 1982.
- 2. This year, the PGPA focuses its professional activities on developing the creativity of guidance counselors. The workshop has the following objectives: (1) to increase awareness of the potentials of creativity in guidance work; (2) to develop a keen sensitivity to creativity in guidance; (3) to acquire scientific skills and techniques in the development of creativity; and (4) to plan guidance programs with the creative component for better, more efficient, and more meaningful delivery of guidance services.
- 3. In view of the importance of the workshop to the Ministry's efforts to upgrade guidance and counseling in schools, all guidance counselors are hereby encouraged to attend the conference.
- 4. A registration fee of P350 will be charged to cover costs of accommodation, meals, materials and use of equipment. Travel funds shall be chargeable against local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 5. In this connection, attention is invited to paragraph 3 of MEC Order No. 17, s. 1982, requiring the sponsor to submit a post-audit report of collections and disbursements. This requirement should be strictly complied with.
