PURCHASE OF GSP UNIFORM FROM GIRL SCOUT COUNCILS

- 1. The Girl Scout of the Philippines is quite alarmed by the rampant illegal manufacture and sale of fake Girl Scout uniform materials which infringe upon their patent rights and their standard for Girl Scout uniform.
- 2. In support of their campaign against unauthorized dealers, this Office requests all school superintendents and heads of schools to encourage their Girl Scout troop leaders to personally take charge of purchasing the uniform needs of their girls directly from their zespective Girl Scout Councils which are the only authorized outlets of their national equipment service.
- 3. It is desired that this Memorandum be given immediate wide publicity for the information and guidance of all the Girl Scout troop leaders in all schools throughout the country.
