1. The U.P. Folklorists, Inc., in coordination with the Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports (MECS) will hold its 2nd Annual Symposium at the U.P. Faculty Center Conference Hall in U.P., Diliman on January 29-30, 1983.
2. The theme of the symposium is: "Philippine Folklore in Education for Nationhood". We hope to develop in our educators an awareness of the value of folklore in developing among our people a sense of nationhood.
3. In view of the worthy objectives of the Symposium and in recognition of the U.P. Folklorists, Inc., role in helping develop in our educators an awareness of the value of folklore in our school system, this Office hereby authorizes the attendance of division supervisors, general education supervisors in charge of Filipino and English program in regional offices and chairman of the Department of Filipino and English in state colleges and universities in this symposium on official time only.
4. A registration fee of fifty pesos (P50) will be charged each delegate to cover expenses for handouts and certificate of attendance. This may be charged against local funds, subject to its availability and existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Transportation allowances and other incidental expenses shall be borne by the delegates themselves. Participants from private schools may make funding arrangements with their respective institutions.
