- 1. Every year Retarded Children's Wook is observed from February 14 to 20, conformably to Preclamation No. 1385 dated February 12, 1975.
- The theme of this year's colebration will be "Toward Independent Living of the Mentally Mandicapped." All schools are enjoined to observe the weak by giving stress on activities designed to develop the handicapped for independent living. Efforts should be directed in providing assistance to enable them to avail themeselves of opportunities for suitable work and to ensure their active integration in society.
- 3. The suggested activities hereunder may be undertaken during the Week.
 - a. Encourage out-of-school mentality handicapped children of school age to attend classes, sheltered workshops, pre-vocational training, etc., available in the country.
 - b. Disseminate information on work capabilities and potentials of the mentally handicapoed/ retarded.
 - Conduct a survey of job opportunities for the mentally handicapped/retarded.
 - d. Hold community assemblies, symposia and/or panel discussion on topics geared to the thome.
 - Conduct day camp, open house, exhibits of finished products, field day, film shows and/ or cultural shows involving mentally retarded children/youth.

All schools are enjoined to cooperate with other government and non-government agencies in the observance of the Week.

3. Immediate and wide discomination of this Momorandum is desired.
