COUNTRY COURSE ON DEVELOPMENT OF MODULAR INSTRUCTIONAL  
MATERIALS FOR TECHNICIAN INSTITUTIONS  
IN THE PHILIPPINES

To: Presidents, State Colleges and Universities  
Vocational School Superintendents/Administrators

1. A Country Course on the Development of Modular Instructional Materials for Technician Institutions in the Philippines will be jointly conducted by the Philippine Government through the Technological University of the Philippines and the Colombo Plan Staff College for Technician Education, Singapore in four (4) phases, consisting of the following:

- Phase I : Workshop to Develop Skills in  
Module  
Venue - MSU Institute of Techno-  
logy  
Duration - 19 January to 27  
February, 1983
- Phase II : Writing/Developing of Modules  
Venue - Respective Institutions  
Duration - Four (4) Months  
(February to May 1983)
- Phase III : Try-Out/Validation  
Venue - Respective Institutions  
Duration - Two (2) Months  
(June to July 1983)
- Phase IV : Evaluation of Draft Copies of Modules  
and Planning for Implementation  
Venue - Technological University  
of the Philippines  
Duration - One (1) Week  
(August 8 to 12, 1983)







2. The purpose of the Country Course is to develop an effective implementation and management of a technical education program with the use of modular approach. Effective modules involve systematic application of basic principles and curriculum and materials development including critical evaluation at all stages of production, validation of the final packet through field trials and evaluative analysis.

3. The enhancement of professionalism among technician teachers and the improvement of the quality of technician education in the Philippines that this Country Course will provide will be one impact.

4. Expected outcomes of the Country Course will be concepts, principles, and techniques necessary for the design, development, and production of effective modules which can be used in actual teaching situation. A manuscript of a module on the case study of the condition of the institutes will be presented by the respective participants.

5. A list of participating institutions is enclosed.

6. Participants in the Country Course will form the core and nucleus for the Iloilo, Visayas, and Mindanao Grid. Two (2) representatives each from the participating institutions who possess the following qualifications may be selected by their school heads to participate in the Country Course:

- a. Previous exposure on modular instruction;
- b. Positive attitude towards the potential of modular instruction in technician education;
- c. Writing ability as evidenced by articles, technical papers or other materials published; and
- d. Commitment to participate in all phases of this project.

7. A participation fee of P650 will be charged each participant. Expenses incident to attendance in the Country Course may be charged against respective institutional funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules.

8. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum to those concerned is desired.
