REGIONAL EDUCATIONAL REORIENTATION PROGRAM FOR DEANS,
ADMINISTRATIVE SUPPORT STAFF AND TEACHER EDUCATORS
OF TEACHER TRAINING INSTITUTIONS

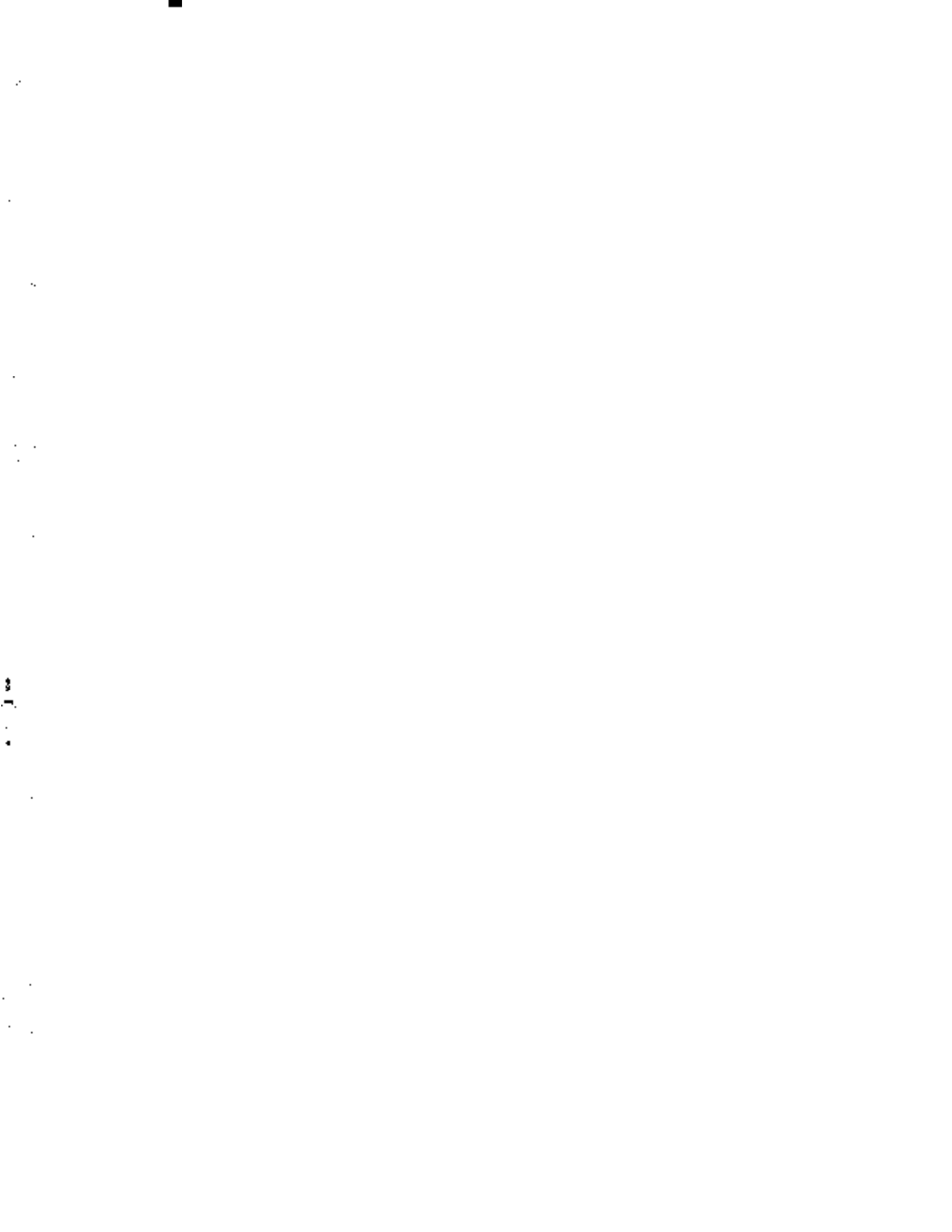
1. The Philippine Association for Teacher Education (PAPTE) and the Bureau of Higher Education, Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports (BHE-MECS), and with financial assistance from the Fund for Assistance to Private Education (FAPE) are jointly sponsoring four regional conferences on various aspects of teacher education, namely: 1) re-orientation of deans, teacher educators and support staff on PRODED thrusts, particularly the New Elementary School Curriculum (NESC) and the proposed Bachelor of Elementary Education (B.E.Ed.) curriculum; 2) human resources development for deans and support staff on program, project and financial management; 3) human resources development for teacher educators on innovative teaching techniques, strategies, and methodologies, and 4) instructional materials development for the proposed B.E.Ed. curriculum.

2. These seminar-workshops are being conducted as an outcome of the First Teacher Educators Assembly held in Baguio City last September 28-30, 1982.

3. These regional conferences will be simultaneously held in the following venues and dates:

a. Manila: NCR and Regions IV and V
University of Santo Tomas
February 15, 16 and 17, 1983

b. Cebu City: Regions VI, VII and VIII
Cebu State College
February 15, 16, and 17, 1983



c. Baguio City: Regions I, II and III
University of Baguio,
February 22, 23 and 24, 1963

d. Davao City: Regions IX, X, XI and XII
Ateneo de Davao
February 22, 23 and 24, 1963

4. Participants to the seminar-workshops will be selected by the heads of institutions. A registration fee of two hundred fifty pesos (250) to cover three lunches and six snacks, conference materials, program and certificates of participation will be charged each participant. Expenses for transportation, board and lodging, registration and other fees connected with attendance in the seminar for participants representing state institutions, including DECS officials, shall be charged against local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules. Expenses of participants representing private institutions shall be borne by their respective schools.

5. The following are authorized to attend the seminar:

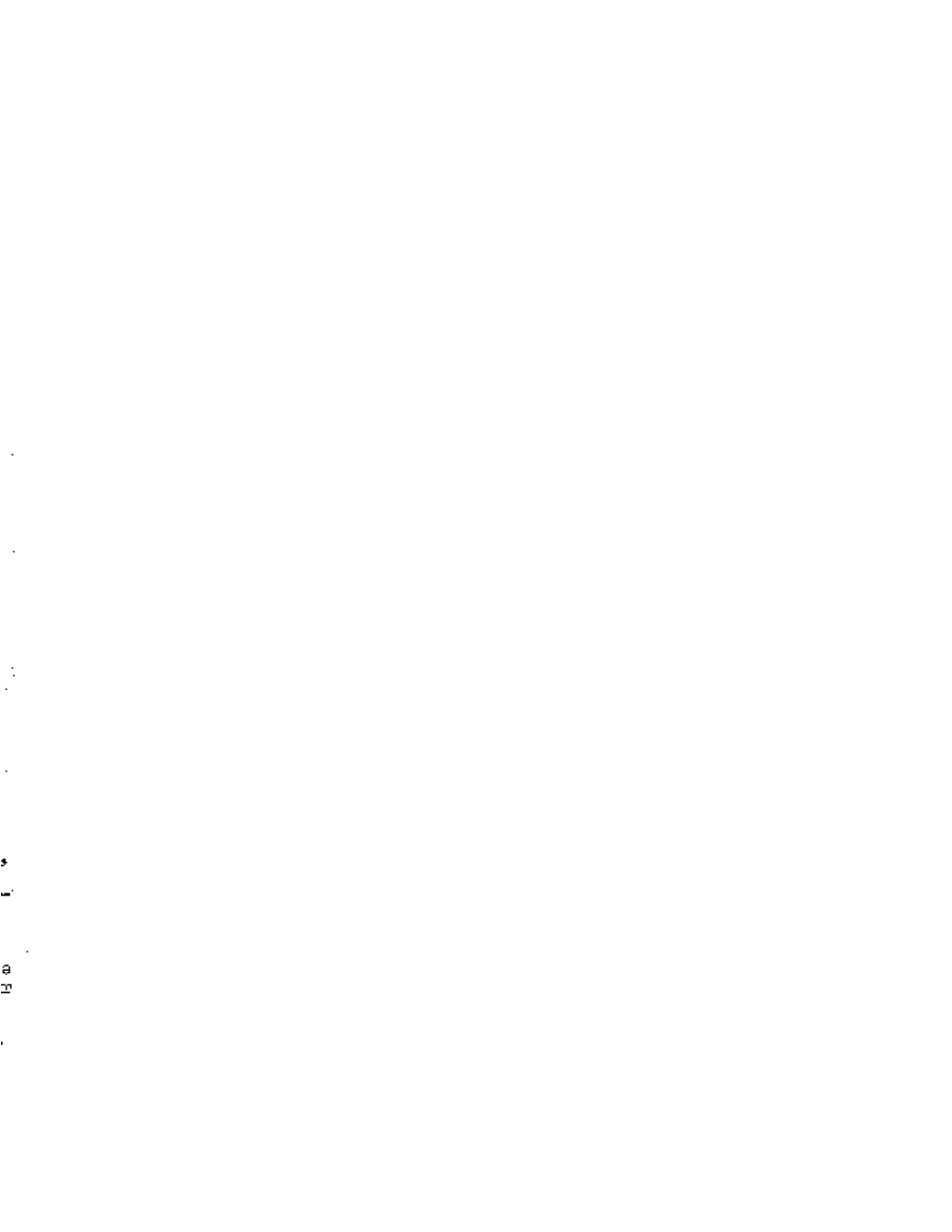
- a. deans of colleges of education;
- b. one administrative support staff;
- c. one or two senior faculty members;
- d. selected BHE-DECS officials; and
- e. chiefs of the higher education divisions in the region.

6. Inclosed are the tentative schedule of activities, list of regions, venues and dates including seminar coordinators and the BHE-DECS offices involved.

7. The BHE shall submit to the Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports, through the Bureau of Higher Education, an accomplishment report within thirty (30) days after completion of the seminar-workshops.

8. Immediate dissemination and implementation of the contents of this Memorandum to all concerned, particularly the Presidents, deans of colleges of education, and senior teachers/educators, is desired.
