3RD ANNUAL CONVENTION/SEMINAR-WORKSHOP OF THE
PAMBANSANG SAMAHAN SA WIKANG INC. (PSW)

1. The Pambansang Samahan sa Wika, Inc. (PSW) in cooperation with the Mariano Marcos State University in Batac, Ilocos Norte and the Fund for Assistance to Private Education (FAPE) and in coordination with the Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports (MECS) will hold its 3rd Annual Convention/Seminar-Workshop at the National Food Authority (NFA) Convention Complex of the Mariano Marcos State University in Batac, Ilocos Norte on April 14-16, 1983.
2. The theme of the convention is "Ang Mabisang Pagtuturo ng Wikang Pambansa sa mga Rehiyong Di-Tagalog" ("The Effective Teaching of the National Language in Non-Tagalog Regions"). Its objectives are: a) to know the situation and direction of the teaching of the national language in non-Tagalog regions, particularly in the Ilocos Region; b) to help the teachers of the national language in non-Tagalog regions become aware of the latest trends in the teaching of language and literature; c) to make teachers in non-Tagalog regions aware that their own native language can help in the development of the National language; and d) to make the teachers in non-Tagalog regions aware that their own native literature can help in the development of the national literature of the Philippines.
3. With the worthy objectives of the seminar-workshop and in recognition of the PSW's role in helping improve the teaching of the National Language in our school system, this Office hereby authorized the attendance of the division supervisors of Filipino together with one or two Filipino

pilot teachers; general supervisors in charge of Filipino programs in regional offices; chairmen of the Department of Filipino or Language in state colleges and universities including one or two Filipino instructors as well as the members of the Pambansang Samahan sa Wika, Inc. who are in good standing. Attendance by personnel of public schools, colleges and universities is on official time only.

4. A registration fee of fifty pesos (P50) will be charged each delegate. The fee may be taken from local funds, subject to its availability and existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Transportation allowance and other incidental expenses shall be borne by the delegates themselves. Participants from private institutions may make funding arrangements with their respective institutions.

5. Enclosed is a detailed information on the seminar-workshop.
