**AUTHORIZING SELECTED SUFFICIARY TECHNICAL INSTITUTIONS TO UNDERTAKE  
REGIONAL BASELINE STUDY ON TECHNICAL AND VOCATIONAL EDUCATION**

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities  
Vocational School Superintendents

1. Conformably with MEC Order No. 49, s. 1981, defining the responsibilities and functions in the implementation of the ADB-Philippines Technical and Vocational Education Project (TVEP) and in pursuance of schedule 6 paragraph 17(a) of Loan Agreement No. 531-PHI providing that NECS shall collect and maintain adequate data for project post-evaluation and to establish baseline data and indicators to measure the socioeconomic impact of the project, the institutions listed in the inclosure are hereby designated as Regional Research Centers of this research project.
2. The designated Regional Research Centers shall conduct the baseline study within a period of six months starting December 1, 1982 in consultation with the TVEP Project Management Staff which shall be the National Coordinating and Monitoring Center of this study.
3. The head of the school is hereby designated as the Research Project Director and is authorized to constitute the research project staff to carry out the research project in collaboration with the Project Manager of TVEP Project Management Staff at Marwin Plaza, Makati, Metro Manila.
4. Funding for the study shall be provided by the budget of the TVEP Project Management Unit covered under specific project orders allocating funds for this purpose. Disbursements of the research fund shall be made in accordance with a duly approved budget indicating the timetable of activities and the expected date of completion to be approved by the TVEP Management Office.
5. Administrators of trade and agricultural schools in the different regions involved in this study are enjoined to extend their full support and cooperation. Teaching and non-teaching personnel coming from the different schools designated by the Research Project Director to assist in the implementation of the project are likewise enjoined to devote part of their time for the assigned task given them.

6. This Memorandum shall take effect immediately and shall remain enforced until the completion of the study. Fifty printed copies of the results of the study should be submitted to the TVET Project Management Office one month after the completion of the project.
