THIRD ANNUAL SEMINAR-WORKSHOP OF THE PHILIPPINE ASSOCIATION  
OF NONFORMAL/COMMUNITY ADULT EDUCATORS

To: Bureau Directors

1. The Philippine Association of Nonformal/Community Adult Education, in cooperation with the Asian Pacific Bureau of Adult Education, Region 3, and the Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports, will hold the third annual seminar-workshop for superintendents or assistant superintendents in charge of nonformal education, regional and division nonformal education supervisors, and other officials in charge of extension service on February 22-25, at the Philippine Public School Teachers Convention Center, Banawe, Quezon City, with the theme, "Evaluating Nonformal Education for National Development."

2. The objectives of the seminar-workshop are to:
- exchange knowledge and experience on evaluation approaches and procedures for NFE Programs used in the participating regions in the areas of literacy, rural development and occupation;
  - identify problems encountered in carrying out NFE program evaluation in the participating regions; and
  - develop viable techniques for strengthening linkages with other governmental and non-governmental agencies.

After the workshop the participants are expected to come up with the following outputs:

- A recommended set of guidelines for evaluating NFE programs on literacy, rural development, and occupational training.







- b. A model evaluation instrument for NFE program on literacy, rural development, and occupational training.
- c. A description of the common as well as the divergent problems in the evaluation of NFE programs among the participating regions.

3. A registration fee of P100. will be charged each participant to partially cover hand-outs, supplies, and other administrative costs, chargeable against local funds and subject to the usual accounting and auditing procedures.

4. Participants are requested to bring with them non-formal education statistics and other information useful for planning and evaluating activities.

5. Inclosed is the tentative program of activities.

6. It is desired that the contents of this Memorandum be immediately brought to the attention of those concerned.
