SECOND NATIONAL BIENNIAL CONFERENCE OF RECSAM GRANTEES

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities
Vocational School Superintendents/Administrators

1. The Philippine Association of RECSAM Grantees (PARC), in coordination with the National Research and Development Center for Teacher Education, Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports, and the Philippine Science High School will hold its second national biennial conference on April 4-6, 1983 at the Philippine Science High School, Aguirre Road, Quezon City.

2. The theme of the conference is "Towards a More Active Participation of RECSAM Grantees in the Implementation of NECS Thrusts Through a Responsive Science and Mathematics Education." This is in support of the Ministry's policy on the maximum utilization of both human and material resources.

3. The objectives of the conference are the following:

- a. Share RECSAM training experience that will contribute to the enhancement of science and mathematics education. This may be in the area of research, instructional material preparation, evaluation, improvisation of equipment, and in-service training.
- b. Update knowledge on current educational thrusts underscoring their implications to science and mathematics education.
- c. Identify one's role in the implementation of these educational thrusts and set goals through the preparation of an action plan.



4. The program of activities will include sharing of experiences in science and mathematics teaching and presentation of papers by resource speakers on current ministry's thrusts in the elementary, secondary and tertiary levels and update science and mathematics education. Expected outputs are action plans on the promotion of science and mathematics education.

5. Other activities are the launching of the Search for Outstanding RGCAM Alumni '83 and election of members of the Board for 1983-1985.

6. Participants in said conference are the alumni of the science and mathematics training programmes conducted by RGCAM, Penang, Malaysia.

7. In view of the timeliness and relevance of the objectives of the conference, RGCAM alumni in the public and private schools are encouraged to attend on official time only. All other expenses except the registration fee, shall be borne by the participant.

8. A registration fee of ₱60 shall be charged each participant to defray cost attendant to the conference activities and of materials. This registration fee may be charged against local funds, subject to its availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules.

9. For the convenience of provincial participants lodging with beddings at ₱10.00 a day is available at the Philippine Science High School Dormitory. Rates for meals are: breakfast, ₱7.50; lunch/dinner, ₱9.50; and snacks, ₱3.00. Reservation should be made early to ensure accommodation.
