FIFTH WORLD CONFERENCE ON GIFTED AND TALENTED
CHILDREN, YOUTH AND ADULTS

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1. The Fifth World Conference on Gifted and Talented Children, Youth and Adults will be held in Manila on August 2-6, 1983 at the Manila Hotel under the sponsorship of Reading Education, Inc. in cooperation with the Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports and the Philippine Conventions Bureau.
2. The general theme of the conference is "Gifted and Talented Children, Youth and Adults: Their Social Perspective and Culture."
3. The objective of the conference is to explore problems, issues and practices correlated with "Gifted and Talented" programs as they have so far evolved from developed and developing countries, and thereby to evolve a commitment to the identification, recognition and development of all gifted and talented children, youth and adults in both developed and developing nations.
4. Presenters of papers are expected from a number of academic disciplines including Education, Psychology, Mathematics, Computer Science, Political and Social Sciences, Humanities, Medicine, Law, as well as the arts, cinema, sports, business and industry; from parent groups and from the Government. In addition to lectures, the conference will feature films, concerts, exhibits and discussion sessions. Workshops will be arranged for teachers, parents, executives and gifted children, youths and adults. Children's art work and projects will be displayed at the conference site, and visits to cultural centers and schools for the gifted will be scheduled.

5. All SPED teachers, SPED supervisors, school officials and educators in the public and private sectors involved in the education of the gifted and talented children and youths are hereby encouraged to attend the conference. Policy-makers in governments and in business as well as other specialists, parents and gifted and talented children may also be invited to participate.

6. A registration fee of US\$80 for participants and US\$40 for children will be charged before April 1, 1983. After that date, the conference fee for participants shall be US\$95. The registration fee herein required may be charged against local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
