A TWO-DAY SEMINAR AND MICRO-TEACHING SESSION  
ON CORRECTIVE AND REMEDIAL READING

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Schools Superintendents  
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities  
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities  
Vocational School Superintendents/Administrators

1. The Reading Association of the Philippines (RAP), in coordination with the Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports, will hold a Seminar and Micro-Teaching Session on Corrective and Remedial Reading, at the Philippine Normal College Main Auditorium, Manila, on May 6-7, 1983.
2. The theme of the seminar and micro-teaching session is "Beyond and Across Reading." The objectives are:
  - a. to upgrade professional competencies in the design and management of corrective and remedial reading programs in English and Filipino;
  - b. to update teachers, supervisors, administrators, reading specialists, coordinators, and parents on the new technology and perspective in reading instruction; and
  - c. to tie-in the session activities with the effective implementation of the DECS New Elementary School Curriculum and the Revised Secondary Education Program.
3. With the objectives of the seminar and micro-teaching session highly supportive of the DECS program of improving achievements in the basics, particularly in Reading, this Office hereby encourages the attendance of division supervisors of English and Filipino, pilot teachers, general education supervisors in charge of the English and Filipino programs in the regional offices, members of the regional curriculum development committees, directors of reading centers, reading specialists and coordinators, chairman of the departments of English and Filipino in colleges and universities, English and Filipino instructors and parents.







4. It is understood that all expenses incurred relative to attendance in this two-day session will be borne by the participants.

5. It should be noted that in order to minimize travel expenses on the part of the participants, this two-day session at PNC Manila will be held immediately after the 1983 PNL convention at U.P. Quezon City, on May 3-5, 1983.

6. A seminar fee of sixty-five pesos (₱65) will be charged each SAP member and seventy-five pesos (₱75) each non-member.

7. Enclosed is a program of activities.

8. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is requested.
