SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM LEADING TO MASTER OF ARTS
DEGREE IN NONFORMAL EDUCATION

To: Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents

1. The Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports hereby announces the resumption of the NFE Scholarship Program at the Philippine Normal College, Manila. The grant covers two semesters and one summer starting the first semester of school year 1983-1984.
2. This scholarship is intended solely for NFE district coordinators actually doing NFE work. It covers tuition, matriculation and miscellaneous fees as well as stipend of P300 a month for the duration of the program.
3. Each region may recommend one district NFE coordinator using the inclosed criteria. Recommendation should be accompanied by CSC Form 212, certificate of moral character, and certificate of performance rating for the last three years. All recommendations should be in the Office of Nonformal Education on or before April 30, 1983.
4. It is desired that this Memorandum be immediately disseminated.

Criteria for NFE Scholarship

1. Educational Qualification - BSE, BSEEd or its equivalent
2. Civil Service Eligibility - Teacher Examination
3. Performance Rating for the last 3 years - V.S.
4. Scholastic Rating - 1.75 (average)
5. Health - Physically fit and emotionally stable as certified by a government physician
6. Age - Between 35 - 40 years old
7. The nominee must not have any pending administrative/criminal case against her as certified by the director of the region
8. When finally selected, the awardee agrees to bind herself to the following conditions:
 - a) Keep up with the standards of scholarship.
 - b) Live up to the terms and conditions of the scholarship.
 - c) Serve the NFE program for a period of at least 2 years for every year of scholarship enjoyed.
 - d) Failure to comply with letter c, refund MECS (OMPE) such amount as may have been defrayed for her salary, tuition fee, etc. during the term of her scholarship.
