"ISANG BANSA, ISANG DIWA" MUSIC INSTRUMENTAL
TAPES FOR ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS

1. In response to the need for song models that can serve as teaching aid for music teachers, the Philippine Society for Music Education (PSME) in cooperation with the Cultural Center of the Philippines, and National Competition for Young Artists (NAMCYA) has prepared its initial taped music and songs for school use. The material, specifically, the tape recording of Filipino text and music is a significant input into the development of Filipinism, the dominant value to be developed through the New Elementary School Curriculum and a useful aid in teaching children to sing the songs correctly and with proper expression.

2. The tape contains 12 songs on Side A aimed at promoting Filipinism and cultural growth. Side B is piano accompaniment (minus one). Muted voicing in the minus one is intended as a guide. With the tape is an accompanying printed vocal music (CAT. No. 8301). Vocal score is also available for students (CAT. No. V-8301). Complete music score is available for teachers at the CCP-NAMCYA (CAT. No. PA-8301).

3. Songs included are the following: Pambansang Awit; Pilipinas kong Mahal; Isang Bansa, Isang Diwa; Bagong Lipunan; Maligayang Bati; Kalesa; Manang Biday, and four ethnic songs: Pantik Manok, Children's Game; Children's Song; Temandan; and Ako'y Pilipino.

4. Since the tapes are intended for classroom use, the Philippine Normal College Children's Chorale, conducted by Myrna P. Saenz with Marites B. Panaligan as piano accompanist did the singing of the songs.
