PAPTE CRYSTAL ANNIVERSARY CONVENTION

1. The Philippine Association for Teacher Education (PAPTE) will hold its annual convention on April 7-8, 1983 at the Pope Pius XII Catholic Center, U.N. Avenue, Manila. The theme of the convention is "PAPTE: Retrospects and Prospects."
2. The convention will assess the contributions of PAPTE in improving the quality of teacher education in the country for the past fifteen years, and also determine its future direction. In addition to the concerns of PAPTE, there will be an academic exchange on the B.S. I.I. curriculum, policies and standards of teacher education and the professional code of ethics for teachers.
3. In view of the benefits that will be derived from the convention's objectives towards improving teacher education, deans of colleges of education and interested teacher educators, and PAPTE members are encouraged to attend this academic gathering.
4. Each participant will pay a registration fee of ₱150 which will cover lunches and snacks for two days, handouts and certificate of attendance. Attendance will be on official time only for participants representing state institutions, including MECS officials. Expenses of participants representing private institutions shall be borne by their respective schools.
5. Inclosed is the Program of Activities for the convention.
6. It is requested that this Memorandum be given wide publicity among school heads, deans of colleges of education and teacher educators.
