75TH ANNIVERSARY OF TEACHERS CAMP

To: Bureau Directors

1. The Teachers Camp in Baguio City, founded on April 6, 1908 is celebrating its 75th Anniversary this year. One feature of the celebration is the launching of a year-round "Visit Teachers Camp Tour Program for 1983".

2. The Ministry enjoins school officials and teachers associations to organize trips to Baguio City and avail themselves of facilities of Teachers Camp at special rates, as follows:

a. For teachers and school officials

Overnight stay . . . . . P 15.00/person  
More than one night . . . . . 10.00 a night  
per person

b. For non-teachers and other guests

Overnight stay . . . . . P 20.00/person  
More than one night . . . . . 10.00 a night per  
person

3. The Camp provides beds and bedding. However, the guests will have to provide their towels and toilet articles. Meals may be arranged upon prior notice.







4. Travel organizers for teachers associations are invited to place their reservations by writing to the Summer School and Teachers Camp Director based in Baguio City at least two weeks before the trip schedule, subject to confirmation by the Camp.
5. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
