SUMMER TRAINING OF TEACHERS (PRODED-ERP)

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Chiefs of Services and Heads of Units
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1. In line with the Ministry's efforts to upgrade the competencies of MECS regional staff, the PRODED-ERP training activities for Grade I teachers in non-affected districts are scheduled for implementation during the summer term of 1983.
2. While the PRODED re-orientation activities have thus far been concentrated on teachers in affected districts as the first priority, it is imperative that all Grade I teachers should be prepared for the implementation of the New Elementary School Curriculum (NEEC), starting school year 1983-84.
3. In view of this, the following should be observed:
 - a. All training sessions for Grade I teachers in non-affected districts are scheduled during the months of April-May 1983. These sessions will be held on a 9-day non-residential basis, at the district level.
 - b. All Grade I teachers who have not undergone the PRODED Teacher Formation Program (TFP) to date, whether in affected or non-affected districts, are expected to be available during these scheduled summer training activities. Arrangements should be made at the regional and sub-regional levels to ensure teacher availability.
 - c. All teachers who complete the PRODED-ERP shall earn service credits, in accordance with existing Ministry policies and procedures.
4. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
