NATIONAL CONGRESS ON LIBRARY DEVELOPMENT

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities
Vocational School Superintendents/Administrators

1. The Philippine Library Association, Inc. with the cooperation of the Fund for Assistance to Private Education (FAPE) will hold the National Congress on Library Development at Valle Verde, Pasig, Metro Manila, on May 19-20, 1983. The theme of the congress is "Library Cooperation and Resources Sharing".
2. Lectures, forums and work sessions will aim to carry out the following objectives:
 - a. To underscore the important role played by libraries in the information dissemination of the government and as functional information centers; and
 - b. To orient librarians on new developments as topics of the congress will include: 1) basic aspects of networking; 2) indexing; 3) abstracting; 4) cataloging; 5) shared cataloging; 6) coordinated acquisition; 7) cooperative indexing; 8) union listing of research reports; 9) resources sharing; and 10) library schools consortium.
3. Each elementary, secondary, national/vocational high school; state college and university; national, provincial, city and municipal library and each division of The National Library is enjoined to send at least one librarian to said congress on official time/service credit only.
4. Each participant will spend a two-hundred-peso registration fee (P200) to cover the lunches, snacks, conference bag and handouts. All expenses shall be personal.
5. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is enjoined.
