INVITATION FOR PHILIPPINE PARTICIPATION IN INTERNATIONAL
EGYPTIAN YOUTH VOLUNTARY WORK CAMP

To: Regional Directors
School Superintendents
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Heads, Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1. The Supreme Council for Youth and Sports (SCYS) in Egypt, through the Embassy of the Arab Republic of Egypt in Manila, has extended its invitation to five male Filipino youths to participate in the International Egyptian Youth Voluntary Work Camp in El-Maher Men Ramadan which will be held from August 5 to 21, 1983.
2. The camp program consists of ten days work and six days tourist program. The work program includes five hours work with one hour break daily; two hours for sports, recreational and cultural activities; seminars and lectures on the influence of peace upon youth; construction of new cities; intercultural youth relationships, etc. The tour program will include visits to the Egyptian Museum, Pyramids and Sphinx in the Giza Area, Khan El Khalili Bazar, Citadel, ancient mosques and the ancient churches in Cairo; the different beaches, Greco-Roman Museum, Pompeii Pillar, Roman Theatre, Antoniadis Parks and Parabolic Monuments in Alex; the city of Is-mailia, Suez Canal Company, Ahmed Hamdi Tunnel, and the City of Suez in the Canal Zone plus a whole day trip to El Fayoum Oasis.
3. The invitation is open to Filipino males from 18 to 30 years of age who can speak English, take part in the social and cultural activities, are in good health, and have not participated in any of the previous work camps.
4. The SCYS will shoulder food, accommodation, medical care and internal transportation throughout the period of the tour. Participants or their respective organizations, however should bear their own travel expenses to and from Cairo.

5. Inclosed is an application form which should be duly accomplished and mailed to: The Egyptian Embassy, 22-29 Paraiso St., Daguerriñas Village, Makati, Metro Manila, for confirmation not later than June 30, 1983. Letters of acceptance will be sent by the Embassy.

6. It is requested that this Memorandum be disseminated immediately.
