1. The Girl Scouts of the Philippines will hold its 21st National Encampment on May 7-17, 1983 at Camp Telesfora Ong Ch, Sta. Ana, Tubay, Agusan del Norte, with "Nature and Scouts' Link with God and His People". This annual event will be attended by about 800 Senior Girl Scouts and Adult Leaders from 85 Girl Scouts Councils all over the country. Such an activity will give the campers enough opportunities for learning and putting into practice desired camp skills, attitudes and values towards group living.

2. In this connection, permission to attend on official time only is hereby granted to all girl scout participants and their respective teacher/loop leaders who will join the encampment.

NATIONAL WORKSHOP AND SUMMER CAMP IN GYMNASTICS

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Schools Superintendents  
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities  
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities  
Vocational School Superintendents/Administrators

1. The Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports, in cooperation with the Philippine Normal College and MECS Gymnastics Association, will hold a workshop for teachers on coaching and officiating in Gymnastics and a summer camp for students in gymnastics on May 9-20, 1983, at the Philippine Normal College Gym.

2. The objectives of the workshop and summer camp are to update and upgrade the competencies of prospective gymnastics coaches and officials in coaching and strategies and develop the skills of student-gymnasts.

3. After the workshop the teachers are expected to:

- a. improve knowledge, skills, strategies and techniques in coaching and officiating gymnastics;
- b. effectively teach and coach students and athletes in gymnastics;
- c. prepare athletes to participate in local, regional, national and ASEAN schools gymnastics competitions with improved athletic and behavioral qualities; and
- d. foster higher level of camaraderie among participants.









4. After the summer camp, the students are expected to have:

- a. improved their knowledges and skills and will be ready for local, regional, and national competitions;
- b. developed an appreciation and love for gymnastics as a sport; and
- c. developed better attitudes and habits of training.

5. A school division may send one young female and one young male teacher who have the inclination and background in gymnastics to attend. Regional and division supervisors as well as physical education teachers/coordinators may also attend to train in officiating a number of students who will attend the summer camp. Each school division should send only one boy and one girl to the summer camp.

6. Registration fee of P100 for teachers and P60 for children or gymnasts shall be charged to cover the cost of materials and other expenses. Attendance in this workshop and summer camp shall be on official time only. Sponsorship may be secured by those interested in attending this exercise.

7. Further details about the workshop and summer camp may be obtained at the Physical Education Department of the Philippine Normal College, Manila.
