CONVENTION OF LAW SCHOOLS

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Heads of State Colleges and Universities
(with Law Schools)

1. A convention of law schools will be held on May 26-29, 1983 at the Hyatt Terraces, Baguio City under the joint auspices of the Philippine Association of Law Schools and the Philippine Association of Law Professors, in cooperation with the Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports, the Integrated Bar of the Philippines, the U.P. Law Center and the Philippine National Committee of the ASEAN Law Association.
2. This Convention aims to examine and propose much needed reforms in legal education and the law profession. Considering the recent reorganization of the judiciary, the sponsors feel it is imperative for the law schools to consider the upgrading of the quality of legal education.
3. The Convention will also tackle issues relating to the Supreme Court and legal education, the ideal role of law schools, the integrity of the bench and the bar, legal resources, continuing legal education, the proposed Legal Education Act in relation to the Education Act of 1982.
4. Participants in the Convention will not only come from the academe, but also from the different law associations, government agencies and private institutions and foundations. Legal educators from other ASEAN countries will also be present. Hence, there promises to be a very fruitful exchange of views which will prove beneficial to the improvement of legal education in the Philippines.

5. Each participant will be charged a convention fee of P300.00 to defray necessary expenses related to the operation of the Convention.
6. Heads of all schools, colleges and universities concerned are hereby enjoined to authorize the participation in the Convention of their law deans and at least two (2) senior law faculty members. The expenses of the MECS officials and school representatives to the convention shall be charged against local or school funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
7. It is desired that this ^{by memorandum} Order be given the necessary publicity to inform all concerned.
