1983 NURSING EDUCATORS CONGRESS

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities  
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities  
Deans, Colleges of Nursing

1. The Association of Deans and Principals of Philippine Colleges and Schools of Nursing, in cooperation with the Bureau of Higher Education, Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports, will hold a three-day national conference on May 25-27, 1983 at the Lung Center, Quezon City.
2. The 1983 Nursing Educators Congress, with the theme "Nursing Education: Retrospect and Prospects", will have the following objectives:
  - a. To review the status of Nursing and Nursing Education;
  - b. To expose the participants to some innovations in Nursing and Nursing Education;
  - c. To present the revised Nursing curriculum and the proposed Rules and Standards on Nursing Education; and
  - d. To prepare a development plan for Nursing Education.
3. The following are encouraged to attend the conference: deans/chairmen/OICs of nursing schools and colleges, department heads of nursing schools and colleges, senior faculty of nursing schools and colleges, and chiefs of higher education divisions in the MEDS regional offices or their respective representatives.
4. A registration fee of three hundred pesos (P300) to cover lunch and snacks for three days and materials will be collected from each participant. Registration fee, transportation and other incidental expenses shall be charged against local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules. Expenses of participants representing private institutions shall be borne by their respective schools.







5. Inclosed is the Program of Activities for the Congress.
6. It is requested that this Memorandum be given wide publicity among school heads and deans of colleges of nursing.
