INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS FOR NESCI IMPLEMENTATION

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities

1. Instructional materials for Grade I for the school year 1983-1984 shall consist of the following:

a. Civics and Culture - Teacher's Package; will be available by June 14, 1983.

- (1) Instructional guide including set of 27 posters (Patnubay sa Pagtuturo)
- (2) Trial edition of a pupil's textbook (Ang Batang Filipino)
- (3) Trial edition of the teacher's guide for the pupil's textbook (Patnubay ng Guro para sa Ang Batang Filipino)

b. English

- (1) Textbook (My Storybook, 1979 ed.) available in the schools
- (2) Teacher's Manual for My Storybook - available in the schools
- (3) Supplementary Teacher's Guide in 2 volumes - Vol. 1 for first semester will be available June 14, 1983; Vol. 2 for second semester will be available October 30, 1983

c. Mathematics

- (1) Textbook (Beginning Math, 1982 ed.) - available in the schools
- (2) Teacher's Edition - available in the schools
- (3) Workbook - consumable material for pupils' use in the second semester will be available October 30, 1983



d. Filipino

- (1) Textbook (Mga Bagong Puno ng Pilipinas, 1982 ed.) available in the schools
- (2) Teacher's Edition available in the schools
- (3) Supplementary Teacher's Guide will be available June 1st, 1983
- (4) Workbook - consumable material for pupils' use in the second semester; will be available October 30, 1983

2. The instructional materials for Civics and Culture will be delivered by PRODELTBS to the division offices 10 days before school opening. Schools superintendents and other personnel concerned are enjoined to see to it that the materials are in the hands of teachers by June 1st.

3. Similarly, every effort should be taken by all concerned to get those materials that will be available later to all pupils and teachers as soon as said materials are ready.

4. Funds for the 1st and 2nd quarters for the distribution of textbooks have been released to the regional directors. The cost of moving the NDSC materials to the end-user schools is chargeable to these funds provided under Memoranda of Agreement for 1983 Textbook Distribution between the regional offices and the Textbook Board Secretariat (TBS).

5. In view of the urgent necessity of providing instructional materials to support the first year implementation of the NECS, the cooperation of all concerned is requested in complying with this Memorandum.

FIRST NATIONAL TECHNO CLUB CONVENTION

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Vocational School Superintendents/Administrators

1. The Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports, in collaboration with the Ministry of Human Settlements and the Technology Resource Center, is sponsoring the First National Techno Club Convention on July 1-2, 1983 in Tacloban City. This convention which coincides with the birthday anniversary of the First Lady and Minister of Human Settlements, Madame Imelda Romualdez Marcos, marks the first year of the Techno Club as a national organization.

2. In view of the significance of the convention and its implications to the overall development program of the National Government, this Office hereby authorizes all regional offices to send at least two (2) delegates to attend the convention in Tacloban. The delegates must be:

a. one officer, preferably the president of the Regional Techno Club Federation for 1983-84;

b. one Regional Techno Club Coordinator.

3. Only the price of a transportation ticket shall be chargeable against local school funds. Other transportation allowances and pocket money shall be shouldered by the delegates themselves. Board and lodging shall be free. No registration fee shall be collected.

4. As a fitting observance of the formal launching of the National Techno Club Confederation, the host region shall oversee the preparations for the convention

in collaboration with the Ministry of Human Settlements and the Technology Resource Center. The host regional director is likewise authorized to create a special task force for this purpose.

5. To insure the success of the convention, however, all regional directors are enjoined to cooperate with the host region. They are invited to the convention to share their time and expertise with the organizers.

6. Immediate dissemination of the contents of this Memorandum is requested.
