SECOND BIENNIAL CONFERENCE ON AGRICULTURAL EDUCATION

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1. The Philippine Association of Agricultural Educators (PASSAGE) is sponsoring the second biennial conference on agricultural education on October 27-28, 1983 at the Pampanga Agricultural College, Magalang, Pampanga centered on the theme "Autonomy and Control in Education for Development."

2. The conference has the following objectives: a) to define more precisely the issues of autonomy and control in agricultural higher education in the Philippines and suggests alternatives for resolving concomitant problems, b) to continue discussion of the state-of-the-art of agricultural education, c) to disseminate recent research findings in agricultural education, and d) to honor distinguished personalities in the field of agricultural education. A technical update program among others will be undertaken to update the participants on the latest development in their respective fields or profession.

3. In this connection, officials concerned are enjoined to allow three (3) of their staff who are PASSAGE members as well as those who are interested to attend the conference.

4. Transportation expenses and conference registration fee of P300 shall be borne by each participant, i.e. expenses are personal. Non-PASSAGE members and other interested staff may also be allowed to attend the conference on official time and shall pay a conference fee of P350.

5. Immediate dissemination of the contents of this Memorandum is enjoined.
