25TH WORLD SCHOOL CHILDREN'S ART EXHIBITION

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors

1. The Korean Children's Center is inviting all Filipino children, 6-12 years old, to take part in the 25th World School Children's Art Exhibition which it will sponsor in cooperation with the Korean ministries of Foreign Affairs, of Culture and Information, and of Education; Korean National Commission for UNESCO; Korean Red Cross, and Korean Culture and Arts Foundation. The exhibition will be held on November 18, 1983 at the Korean Children's Center in Seoul.
2. The purpose of this cultural event is to promote international understanding, strengthen friendship among the children of the world, and encourage them in art education through the exchange of their art works.
3. The exhibition is open to children of all countries, individually or in group, between the ages of 6 and 12. Participants may use any medium and entries should not be over 45 cm. x 55 cm. Each participant should submit only one entry on any theme. At the back of each entry the following information - name, age, sex, name of school, address, nationality, and theme - should be written in English and in block letters. Entries without these particulars will not be accepted.
4. Entries should be sent direct to the Korean Children's Center, Cultural Department, San 3-39, Neungdong, Secungdong-ku, Seoul Korea, in time to be received there not later than July 15, 1983. They may be sent in bundles if there are more than one entry from one school.







5. The following prizes will be awarded to deserving entries - the grand superior, gold, silver and bronze medals and certificate for the good works and selected works. Submitted paintings for the exhibition will not be returned to owners. Exhibiting organizations may request for Korean children's works in exchange. The prizes and certificates will be sent to the schools concerned, directly or through diplomatic channels.

6. Dissemination of the contents of this Memorandum, particularly at the opening of SY 1983-84, is desired so that as many pupils as are interested can participate in the contest.
