PHILIPPINE GENERAL AVIATION WEEK

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1. As mandated in Presidential Proclamation No. 2213, by His Excellency, President Ferdinand E. Marcos, the third week of June of every year is designated as Philippine General Aviation Week. This year, it is on June 12-18. The celebration, also in line with the above cited Proclamation, will be spearheaded by the Philippine Multi-Sectors Aviation Council (PMAC) and chaired by the Aircraft Owners and Pilots Association of the Philippines (AOPAP). The theme for this year's observance is "General Aviation for National Economic Development."

2. This Office approves the national observance of Philippine General Aviation Week and suggests the undertaking of the following activities:

- a. For teachers to call attention of all school pupils/students to the observance of the Week by writing conspicuously on bulletin and blackboards its theme and carrying inside the classroom appropriate discussions on the role of aviation to our country's progress in particular and to world progress in general.
- b. For secondary students to research on careers and opportunities in aviation.
- c. For school administrators to revive the objectives and activities of Aviation Week; and
- d. For revitalizing the work of the Aviation Advisory Council of the Philippines and the Aviation Technical Committee.

3. All schools in Metro Manila shall encourage their pupils and students to see the addresses, air in aircraft displays, fly-bys, sky jumpings and model airplane competitions at the Villamor Air Base, Nichols, Pasay City, on June 18 and 19, starting at 8:00 in the morning of both days.

The cooperation and support of all concerned is enjoined.
