- SECOND NATIONAL CONFERENCE ON ARCHITECTURAL EDUCATION

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities
Deans, Colleges of Architecture

1. The United Architects of the Philippines, in cooperation with the Bureau of Higher Education, Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports, will hold a two-day national conference on July 8 and 9, 1983 at the Asian Institute of Tourism, Quezon City;
2. The Second National Conference on Architectural Education, with the theme "Architectural Education: Retrospect and Prospects" will have the main objectives:
 - a. To review the 5-yr. Ladder Type curriculum on Architecture as per MEC Order No. 32, s. 1979;
 - b. To formulate the Rules and Standards for Architectural Education; and
 - c. To expose the participants to some innovations in Architectural Education;
3. The following are encouraged to attend the conference: deans/chairmen/OICs of colleges of architecture together with a senior faculty and chiefs of higher education divisions in the NECS regional offices or their respective representatives.
4. A registration fee of three hundred pesos (P300.00) to cover lunch and snacks for two days and materials will be collected from each participant. Registration fee, transportation and other incidental expenses shall be charged against local funds subject to

the usual accounting and auditing rules. Expenses of participants representing private institutions shall be borne by their respective schools.

5. It is requested that this Memorandum be given wide publicity among school heads and deans of colleges of architecture.
