SPI CALENDAR OF SCIENCE EDUCATION ACTIVITIES
FOR SY 1983-1984

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Chiefs of Services and Heads of Units
Schools Superintendents
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1. Inclosed for the information and guidance of the field is the 1983-1984 Calendar of Activities of the Science Promotion Institute (SPI-NSIA). These activities are designed to promote and develop science and technology consciousness among the youth and the general public through the organization and mobilization of science clubs in schools, colleges and universities.
2. The calendar starts with activities for the celebration of the National Science Club Month in September, in accordance with Presidential Proclamation No. 1895, dated 4 September 1979. Other activities that the SPI underscores are the Sigma Awards, Herbal and Medicinal Garden Contest, Rank Advancement Program, Survey of Science Clubs, 1983 Search for TOYS (district level up to the national level), Science Quiz Development Program, Science Camps, Youth Research Apprenticeship Action Program, Science Club Advisers Leadership Training Program, Youth Science Clubs activities as well as those of the Science Club Advisers Association.
3. These activities are intended to support the science and mathematics programs of the Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports and the development of aesthetic and social values of the young. Therefore, the participation/involvement of the school pupils and students in these activities is basically voluntary in nature. However, the cooperation and support of all concerned is earnestly requested to insure the effective and successful conduct of these activities. Nevertheless, care should be exercised in undertaking them to avoid undue-disruption of or interference with the regular school program.

4. Details of ~~implementation~~ of these activities at each level will be worked out by the SPI-NSTA representative with the teachers and school officials concerned at their respective levels and accordingly announced to all concerned.
5. Regional and division science supervisors and teachers of Science and Mathematics; Science-Math club advisers and members; and all others involved in the promotion of Science and Mathematics such as the non-formal education coordinators, school paper advisers and campus writers, are enjoined to extend cooperation to the SPI representatives, as well as to maximize their support, attendance and actual participation in the calendared activities.
6. Travel and other expenses incident to the participation of those concerned (national level participants only) shall be charged against SPI-NSTA funds. Other school officials who would like to attend the national, regional and local activities as observers will be allowed official time only.
7. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
