NATIONAL SEMINAR IN HOME ECONOMICS

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1. The Philippine Home Economics Association (PHEA), in cooperation with the Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports, will hold its National Seminar on August 24-26, 1983 at the Filinvest Auditorium, United Nations Avenue, Manila. It will be highlighted by the launching of the "HERS" (Home Economics Recognition for Service) Award.

2. The theme of the seminar is "Home Economics ... Meeting the Challenges of the '80s". It seeks to:

- a. evolve a plan of action that will effectively meet the curricular changes in the elementary level and the priorities in the secondary and tertiary levels with respect to Home Economics Education;
- b. strengthen Home Economics Education as a value for the development and intensification of Filipinoism and professional values and attitudes;
- c. intensify active participation in the government's thrusts for socioeconomic uplift; and
- d. launch an incentive program that will extend recognition to outstanding home economists who have excelled in their respective lines of endeavor.

3. Participants in this seminar are regional and division Home Economics Supervisors/coordinators, administrators and heads of Home Economics departments in public and private schools, colleges and universities, officers of Home Economics Associations, selected teachers of Home Economics/Vocational teachers who will be listed by their own regional/division supervisors, and other home economists interested to



4. A tentative program of activities is enclosed. Resource speakers have been invited to share their expertise with emphasis on the concepts reflected in the objectives.
5. A registration fee of One hundred pesos (P100) will be charged per participant to defray cost of materials and seminar expenses including snacks and meals. This will be remitted to the registration committee by regions. All expenses relative to attendance in this seminar may be charged against local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
6. To ease registration during seminar days, participants are requested to pre-register with their regional supervisors in charge of Home Economics through their Home Economics supervisor. Regional supervisors will register the group as a whole on seminar day.
7. In view of the valuable experience and educational benefits that may be derived from the seminar, each region is enjoined to send their choice representatives who will be able to echo valuable and worthwhile information in accordance with the objectives of the seminar.
8. Immediate and wide dissemination of the contents of this Memorandum and full support of all concerned are hereby enjoined.
