IMPLEMENTATION OF THE MASTER IN TECHNICIAN  
EDUCATION (MTE) SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities  
Vocational School Superintendents/Administrators

1. The Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports in support of its Technical Vocational Education Program (TVEP) being aided by the Asian Development Bank will implement a twelve (12) month scholarship program in the approved MTE course for qualified teachers from selected trade technical schools starting school year 1983-1984 as embodied in NECS Order No. 38, s. 1982. This grant is given to improve the technical and academic competencies of selected teachers who will teach in the 23 project institutions.
2. The selected scholars under this program, list enclosed, shall attend classes at the National Center for Teacher Education and Staff Development (NCTESD), Marikina Institute of Science and Technology (MIST), Marikina, Metro Manila, as the degree granting institution, in consortium with Manila Technician Institute (MTI), Taguig, National Manpower Youth Center (NMYC), Office of Manpower Skills Development, Taguig, and Don Bosco Technical Institute, Makati, all in Metro Manila. Three specializing in Mathematics and Science shall attend classes at the MIST and MTI.
3. Scholarship funds and other allowance shall be provided by the TVEP-NECS program. In addition a grantee under this scholarship program shall be allowed travelling expenses from his station to MIST and return, and additional monthly stipend of P200 chargeable against local school funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing regulations.
4. Presidents of state colleges and universities, superintendents and school administrators of the different schools and colleges involved in this scholarship program are authorized to hire qualified







substitute teachers to fill the positions vacated, chargeable against local funds or those authorized under the project recurrent cost provided for this purpose.

5. The contents of this Memorandum should be disseminated to all concerned for their guidance and information.
