FIRST NATIONAL CONFERENCE ON PHARMACY EDUCATION

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities
Deans, Colleges of Pharmacy

1. The Philippine Association of Colleges of Pharmacy (PACCP), with the Bureau of Higher Education, Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports, will hold a three-day national conference on August 11-13, 1983 at the Philippine Women's University, Taft Avenue, Manila.
2. This national conference on Pharmacy Education, with the theme "Pharmacy Education: Retrospect and Prospects", has the following main objectives:
 - a. To revise the Bachelor of Science in Pharmacy Curriculum to align it with the proposed General Education Course and to determine its relevance to the present needs of society;
 - b. To formulate policies and standards for Pharmacy Education in the country; and
 - c. To make a development plan for the Association relative to the improvement of Pharmacy Education in the country.
3. The following are encouraged to attend the conference: deans of colleges of pharmacy, together with senior faculty members and chiefs of higher education divisions in the KES regional offices, or their respective representatives.
4. A registration fee of one hundred eighty pesos (P180.00) to cover lunch and snacks for three days and materials will be collected from each participant. Registration fee, transportation and other incidental expenses shall be charged against local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules. Expenses of participants

representing private institutions shall be borne by their respective schools.

5. It is requested that this Memorandum be given wide publicity among school heads and deans of colleges of pharmacy.
