REGIONAL CONFERENCES TO IMPLEMENT THE CURRICULUM MATERIALS  
ON AGRARIAN REFORM (PHASE II)

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Chiefs of Services and Heads of Units  
Schools Superintendents  
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities  
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1. The Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports, in cooperation with the Ministry of Agrarian Reform, will conduct regional conferences from September 19 to October 11, 1983, to implement the curriculum materials on agrarian reform developed for elementary, secondary and higher education levels for integration into appropriate subject areas.

2. Instructional materials developed for the following academic grade levels shall be fully implemented during the current school year 1983-1984.

- a. Higher Education - English modules 1 to 10  
and Instructor's Manual
- b. Secondary Education - First, Second, Third and  
Fourth Year Teachers' Guides
- c. Elementary Education - Kindergarten posters, Grades  
One, Two, and Three Readers  
and Manuals; Grades Four,  
Five and Six Teachers' Guides  
and accompanying posters

3. The implementation activity shall be limited to one class for each of the specified academic grade levels in all schools of

5. The activities in each venue shall be held for two days. The conference for the elementary level shall be held on the first day, and the conference for the secondary and higher levels shall be held simultaneously on the second day. In the National Capital Region, only the higher level will hold conference since the orientation for the elementary and secondary levels in this region had been held in 1981. Regional directors/schools superintendents shall decide the conference venues for the elementary, secondary and tertiary levels.









6. Inclosed is the list of members of the MAR-VECS curriculum consultants and the participants in these regional conferences. Participants shall conduct echo-conferences in their respective school divisions after the regional conferences.
7. Regional directors and other officials of the Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports shall coordinate with their local counterparts from the Ministry of Agrarian Reform for the successful administration of the regional activity.
8. Accordingly, all bureau and regional directors are enjoined to inform and allow the participants to attend the conferences on official time. Travel expenses, per diem and allowances of the MAR-VECS curriculum consultants who will conduct the conferences shall be charged against the Fund for Agrarian Reform Education (FARE) of the Ministry of Agrarian Reform.
9. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
