SUGGESTED ACTIVITIES DURING THE WEEK

Theme: The School and the Ideology for Filipinos

1. Ecumenical religious service to mark the beginning of the Week
2. Literary-musical programs on the theme or any sub-theme
3. Contests: essay-writing, oratorical, literary-musical, etc.
4. Agricultural exhibits featuring significant food production projects/products
5. KKK product exhibits
6. Radio broadcasts, TV programs on the theme or sub-themes
7. School-community sportsfest (Revival of traditional Filipino games.)
8. School open house and exhibits with the parents and the community as guests
9. Awards for outstanding teachers, school officials, etc.
10. Cookfest to demonstrate preparation of locally-produced food
11. On-the-spot painting/drawing/sketching contest
12. Poster-making contest
13. Intervisitation of classes, schools
14. Playground mass demonstration: calisthenics, gymnastics, folk dances
15. Community assembly or forum on the theme
16. Parade to depict cultural revival
17. School-visit-day. Parents are invited to observe their children at work and at play in school.
