1983 ALAY TANIM AND SCHOOL HEALTH GUARDIAN PROGRAM CONTESTS

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Vocational School Superintendents/Administrators

1. The Eighth Alay Tanim and School Health Guardian Program Contests will be conducted this year.
2. The contests are being held in compliance with the provisions of LOI Nos. 586; 872(G) and 764, strengthening in the school divisions the implementation and integration of all programs/projects, like Alay Tanim/Orchard Development and Food Production; Supplementary Reading; Health Services; Nutrition/Health Education; Environmental Sanitation and Utilization/Effective Use of Medicinal Plants.
3. National/Regional winners in the contests will be given cash prizes by the School Health Nutrition Center (SHNC).
4. At least fifteen (15) or more schools in every division shall be visited by the national evaluation teams to foster improvement and progress in old schools and likewise involve new schools in the implementation of the abovementioned SHNC programs/projects. All regional directors are requested to submit, without categorizing, the names of the best three (3) divisions within their respective regions for evaluation by the national teams whose decisions will be final.
5. School divisions that have won on the national level for the last three (3) consecutive years and school divisions that have won for five (5) consecutive years on the regional level shall not be included in the national and regional evaluation for 1983, but will be given an award every year thereafter provided the projects are continuously improved and maintained.
6. Division entries should be submitted to Dr. Vedasto G. Suarez, Assistant Chairman, National Evaluation Committee, MECS, Manila on or before September 30. Evaluation of division entries will follow immediately. However, evaluation of the 126 school divisions shall be throughout the year and not only during the contests.

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7. Inclosed are guidelines for the contests and list of officials of evaluation teams for ready reference.
8. Immediate wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
