CONFERENCE ON PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION/MANAGEMENT EDUCATION

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities  
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities  
Deans, Colleges of Public Administration

1. The Association of Schools of Public Administration in the Philippines (ASPAP), in cooperation with the UP College of Public Administration and the Bureau of Higher Education, Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports, will hold a three-day national conference on November 23-25, 1983 at the Asian Institute of Tourism, U. P. Diliman, Quezon City.
2. With the theme "Current Challenges to Public Administration/Management Education in the Philippines," this conference on Public Administration/Management Education will have the following objectives:
  - a. To assess the present curricular offerings in public administration/management education programs;
  - b. To discuss issues, problems and current concerns in public administration/management education programs;
  - c. To formulate policies and guidelines on public administration/management education programs; and
  - d. To discuss current trends and innovations towards more relevant public administration/management education programs;
3. After the conference, it is expected that the participants will come up with proposed policies and guidelines for Public Administration/Management Education, a proposed curriculum, and plans of action.



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4. The following are authorized/required to attend the conference: deans of the College of Public Administration and at least two (2) senior faculty members of the college, division chiefs and selected educational researchers of the DHE central office, and the MECS regional directors or their representatives.

5. A registration fee of three hundred pesos (P300) to cover lunch and snacks for three days, and expenses for materials will be collected from each participant. The registration fee, transportation and other incidental expenses shall be charged against local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules.

6. For state colleges and universities, please see attached authorization of the Office of Budget and Management to attend this conference. Expenses of participants representing private institutions shall be borne by their respective schools.

7. Enclosed is a copy of the Program of Activities for the conference.

8. It is requested that this Memorandum be given the widest dissemination among school heads and deans of colleges of public administration.
