TWELFTH NATIONAL CONFERENCE OF CHIEFS AND ASSISTANT CHIEFS
OF ELEMENTARY EDUCATION DIVISIONS AND PRODED PROJECT
TECHNICAL STAFF (PTS) REGIONAL PLANNING
AND MANAGEMENT TEAM (RPMT) DIALOGUE

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents

1. The Twelfth National Conference of Chiefs and Assistant Chiefs of Elementary Education Divisions, as announced in MECS Memorandum No. 168, s. 1983 will be held jointly with PRODED-PTS/RPMT Dialogue in Region IX, Zamboanga City on October 24-28, 1983. The theme of the conference is "Accountability in Elementary Education." Inclosed is a tentative schedule of activities for the conference.

2. It is expected that at the end of the conference the participants would have:

- a. been updated on the status of the various elementary education projects particularly PRODED (e.g. MESC, ERP, Facilities, Research, Technical Assistance, etc.)
- b. defined the accountability of school officials on the:
 - (1) implementation of the new elementary school curriculum
 - (2) continuing staff development program
 - (3) production and utilization of instructional materials
 - (4) management of physical facilities
 - (5) expansion of special education programs.
- c. clarified procedure in recording and reporting pupil progress

d. finalized guidelines for the implementation of the tryout of the Grade III Curriculum of the NESC

e. clarified issues and problems.

3. The participants are as follows:

- Chiefs and Assistant Chiefs of Elementary Education Divisions
- PROCEED Project Technical Staff (PTS)
- Regional Project and Management Team (RPMT)

They are requested to bring the status report on the implementation of PROCEED sub-projects.

4. Each participant shall be charged a registration fee of P500 and travel funds shall be chargeable against local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

5. This supersedes NESC Memorandum No. 168, s. 1983.

6. It is desired that this Memorandum be disseminated to all concerned.
