14TH INTERNATIONAL CHILDREN'S ART EXHIBITION

To: Bureau Directors

1. The International Children's Art Exhibition is an annual event organized with the aim of encouraging cultural exchange and mutual understanding among the children of the world. This year, the organizers, Nippon Taishokan Network Cultural Society and the Foundation for Art Education in Tokyo, Japan, are inviting the Filipino children to send entries of their paintings for the 14th exhibition.

2. For the information and guidance of all concerned, listed below are the entry rules:

a. Subject: The choice of subject is free; but it must be the child's own original work.

b. Number of Entries: Only one work may be submitted by each child.

c. Age Limit: Children shall be aged not less than three (3) years and not more than fifteen (15) years, on January 1, 1981.

d. Size of Works: The size of painting shall not exceed 18 x 24 x 54 cm.

e. The following particulars must be indicated on the reverse side of each painting:

3. It is requested that each school submitting entries accomplish, typewritten or printed, a "List of Entries" based on the particulars mentioned under letter "e" of the preceding paragraph. The entries are to be numbered consecutively.
