CODHEEP ANNUAL CONFERENCE-WORKSHOP

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities  
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1. The Council of Deans and Heads of Home Economics of the Philippines (CODHEEP), with the cooperation of the Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports (MECS), will hold its Annual Conference-Workshop at the University of the East Graduate School, Claro M. Recto Avenue, Manila on November 10-11, 1983. Inclosed is the tentative program of activities.

2. Pursuant to national goals, the theme of the annual conference-workshop is "Cornerstones of Home Economics in the Philippine Setting Today: Filipinoism, Humanism, Worthy Home Membership, Productivity." The objectives are:

- a. to identify the specific activities/projects in the teaching of Filipinoism, Humanism, Worthy Home Membership, Productivity in and out of the classroom.
- b. to adopt effective teaching methodologies that will effectively lead to the formation/development of desirable values and attitudes among the youth.
- c. internalize values and attitudes brought about by the strengthening of the Filipino family which is the basic unit of society.

3. On account of the timeliness and significance of the theme and objectives of the conference, all heads of schools concerned are enjoined to send delegates to the conference-workshop. Bureau of Higher Education staff and the chiefs of higher education divisions and/or supervisors particularly for Home Economics in the MECS regional offices, are expected to attend.







4. Attendance is on official time. Registration fee is P50 to cover snacks and handouts. Expenses to be incurred by the delegates from MECS and state schools are chargeable against their respective offices and school funds, subject to its availability and the usual accounting and auditing procedures. The delegates/participants from the private institutions may have their own arrangements with their respective schools.

5. Immediate dissemination and implementation of the contents of this Memorandum is desired.
