FOURTH NATIONAL POPULATION QUIZ SHOW

1. The Fourth National Population Quiz Show which will be produced by the Population Center Foundation (PCF) for the Commission on Population (PCPOK) will be held on November 26, 1983. It will be aired live over RPN-9 via domestic satellite from 5:00 to 6:00 p.m., simulcast over RPN's 24 provincial TV stations and 14 radio stations, replayed over EFM on the same date from 7:00 to 8:00 p.m., and replayed over Radio Mindanao Network's 30 AM radio stations on December 4, 1983 from 7:00 to 8:00 p.m.

2. This National Quiz Show will be the last level of the 1983 Population Quiz Show which is a series of nationwide contest among high school students from both government and private schools that was started at the district level and continued at the provincial and regional levels. The 1983 Quiz Show, as per MECS Memorandum No. 112, s. 1983, is a joint project of the PCPOK and its Regional Offices, MECS Population Education Program Unit and MECS regional offices, and PCF.

3. It is enjoined that the Quiz Show be given wide publicity among school staff and/or students, particularly high school students, as well as parents of students and other sectors of the public so that they can watch the show on RPN-9 or listen to its broadcast.

4. Dissemination of the contents of this Memorandum to all concerned is desired to ensure the success of this project.
