SEARCH FOR THE TEN MOST OUTSTANDING
STUDENT LEADERS IN THE PHILIPPINES

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1. The youth has been and always will be a potent indispensable resource of the country. Drawing the youth leaders together and recognizing their capabilities will bring about formidable and beneficial results. Towards this end, Youth Development Affairs, Office of the President of the Philippines, through the Youth Action Development Organization (YADO), in close coordination with this Ministry, announces the Search for the Ten Most Outstanding Student Leaders in the Philippines.

2. A school is entitled to one (1) representative. It is suggested that transportation to and from the venue for the activities and other incidental expenses incurred by each nominee shall be charged against the miscellaneous funds of the school/college/university concerned or against any available local funds.

3. The first (preliminary), second and third (final) screenings will be held at the Development Academy of the Philippines, Tagaytay City to coincide with the five (5) days National Workshop on Role of the Youth in Community National Development scheduled on December 26-30, 1983.

4. To ensure quality and fairness, the following will be considered as bases for the selection:

- a. Must be a college student;
- b. Must submit a personal bio-data;
- c. Actively involved in both academic and extra-curricular activities to be attested to by the Dean for Student Affairs;

4. Actively involved in community affairs to be attested to by the Barangay Captain and/or the local executive; and
 5. Shall write an essay on: "The Role of Filipino Student Leaders as Future Inheritors of this Country." The manuscript should be type-written double-spaced on legal size bond paper and certified by the principal/director/head teacher of the school, as the case may be, that it is the original work of the author.
5. Immediate dissemination of the contents of this Memorandum to all colleges and universities is desired.
