NATIONAL SEMINAR-WORKSHOP ON MUSIC EDUCATION

To: Director Dep. Ed.

1. The Philippine Board of for Music Education (PSME) with the cooperation of the Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports will hold a national-workshop on music education at the Cultural Center of the Philippines (CCP) Little Theater on December 2-4, 1983 on the theme: "Music Teaching Strategies and Materials for Developing a Sense of Humanism and Filipinism."
2. The objectives of the seminar-workshop are:
 - a. to explore ways and means of enhancing the musical and teaching skills of classroom and music teachers to enable them to meet the objectives of music education in relation to the new thrust in elementary education; and
 - b. to present music teaching strategies and materials designed to help promote Humanism and Filipinism while at the same time providing for musical growth and understanding.
3. Among the activities in the seminar-Workshop are the following:
 - a. Teaching demonstration on "Sibika at Kultura"
 - b. Workshop on basic vocal techniques for young voices
 - c. Skill singing and analysis of suitable Filipino songs for classroom use
 - d. Ratification of proposed amendments to the PSME Constitution.



4. Regional, division and district supervisors, special music teachers and classroom teachers in the elementary level as well as music teacher-training teachers in the college level are encouraged to attend the seminar. Participants are encouraged to make their own arrangements for funding their participation in the seminar.

5. A seminar fee of P110 to cover expenses for handouts and other materials as well as membership fee for 1983-84 will be charged.

6. Registration of delegates shall be on Friday, December 2 at 8:00-9:00 a.m. in the lobby of the CCP Little Theater. However, those who wish to pre-register may do so at the Philippine Normal College, Manila, care of Dr. Loreto Gloria from November 7 to December 1, to be assured of a reservation.

7. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
