22ND NATIONAL RIZAL YOUTH LEADERSHIP INSTITUTE

Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1. The Order of the Knights of Rizal, with the cooperation of the Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports, will hold its 22nd National Rizal Youth Leadership Institute on December 26-30, 1983, in Teachers Camp, Baguio City, in commemoration of the 87th death anniversary of Dr. Jose P. Rizal. The over-all theme will be "Rizal and the Spirit of Reconciliation."
2. The annual event calls for the involvement of students in the youth sector for the purpose of enriching their off-campus education in the areas of character building, citizenship training, personal discipline and progressive leadership.
3. Five sub-topics will be discussed namely: (a) Rizal and the Spirit of Justice, (b) Rizal and the Spirit of Freedom, (c) Rizal and the Spirit of Democracy, (d) Rizal and the Spirit of Truth, and (e) Rizal and the Spirit of Peace.
4. The guest speakers in the seminar are Chief Justice Enrique Fernando, His Eminence Jaime Cardinal Sin, Dr. Paz Policarpio Mendez, Professor Jose David Lopez, Mgfr. Leonardo Z. Legarda, D.P., and Gen. Romeo C. Espino.
5. All schools, colleges and universities, both public and private, are enjoined to send delegates to the seminar. A registration fee of P200 shall be charged each participant to cover transportation expenses from Manila to Baguio City and return, board and lodging, and seminar materials. Students from government institutions may be supported from local funds, subject to availability and the usual accounting and auditing regulations. The private schools may have their own arrangements regarding the expenses of their respective delegates.
