SURVEY OF HIGH SCHOOL SENIOR STUDENTS FOR THE ADMISSION  
TEST TO TECHNICIAN EDUCATION AND OF INDUSTRIAL  
AND MANUFACTURING ESTABLISHMENTS

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Schools Superintendents  
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities  
Vocational School Superintendents/Administrators

1. A survey of high school senior students will be undertaken from November 10 to December 10, 1983 by 21 technician institutes within their respective regions to determine the number of students interested to participate in the region-wide admission test for technician courses. The schedule of the admission test will be from January 17 to February 29, 1984. The successful candidates will be admitted as first year for school year 1984-1985.
2. Secondary school graduates and graduating students who are 17 to 25 years old, physically fit, and at least five feet tall will be the target of the survey. During the survey, interested students will be interviewed in proficiency in mathematics, science, physics and communication arts - subjects that are very crucial in the technician courses.
3. Hand-in-hand with this activity is the survey of industrial and manufacturing establishments within the service area of each institute for the purpose of information dissemination and to gather data on the potential capabilities of these establishments to accept technician students for laboratory shop practice and on-the-job training.
4. In the survey of industrial and manufacturing establishments, the team will look into the capabilities of the establishments in the following technology areas:

Electronics  
Electrical  
Refrigeration and  
Airconditioning  
Automotive

Mechanical  
Welding and Fabrication  
Woodworking  
Building Construction







These are the areas from where successful candidates will choose their preference for specialization for the 2-year or 3-year technician course.

5. The results of the survey will be discussed in the Third Administrators Conference of participating schools on December 19-20, 1983 at the National Center for Technical Education and Staff Development, Marikina Institute of Science and Technology.

6. The Project Management Unit (PMU) of the Technical and Vocational Education Project-MECS shall provide the funds for this project.

7. It is desired that this Memorandum be widely disseminated and brought to the attention of all concerned.
