SEMINAR-WORKSHOPS ON THE TEACHING OF FAMILY PLANNING
IN THE MIDWIFERY CURRICULUM

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1. The Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports, in coordination with the Institute of Public Health, University of the Philippines, Manila, Population Center Foundation and Population Commission will conduct two (2) seminar-workshops on the teaching of Family Planning in the midwifery curriculum, on December 6-16, 1983 and January 9-20, 1984, at the Philippine Nurses' Association Headquarters, Kansas Avenue, Manila.
2. The two-week seminar-workshops are the fourth phase of a project undertaken toward strengthening the Family Planning component of the midwifery curriculum. The main objective of the seminar-workshops is to prepare selected faculty members for the teaching of the separate course in family planning prior to its offering as a 3-unit course in the midwifery curriculum.
3. In view of the importance of preparing midwifery faculty in teaching the family planning component of the midwifery course, all heads of schools concerned are enjoined to send preferably two (2) participants to the seminar-workshops in accordance with the enclosed schedules.
4. Transportation expenses of participants from other ministries are chargeable against their own funds, subject to its availability and the usual accounting and auditing procedures. Participants from the private institutions may have their own arrangements with their respective schools.
5. Per diem of ₱75 a day for each participant to defray expenses for board and lodging for the two-week seminar-workshops will be funded by the project. Participants will make their own arrangement for board and lodging.
6. Immediate dissemination of this memorandum is desired.
