1983 PROBLEM'S DAY ARE MOTHER'S DAY COLFERATIONS

- The National Federation of Momen's Clubs (NFAC), with the cooperation of the Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports is spearheading this year's collaboration of Father's Day and Mother's Day. Pursuant to Proclamation No. 2037 dated November 27, 1980, Father's Day and Mother's Day will be celebrated every year on the first Sunday and Pirst Monday, respectively, of December.
- 2. To inculcate in our children and youth and thereby preserve the Filipino virtue and tradition of deep respect for parents, it is requested that all schools colobrate these significant days and lead the community in the observance of the colombrations.
- 3. Some suggested activities for the colebrations, in addition to discussion of the thomas in subjects like Pilipino, English and Social Studies are the following:
 - a. Hold Flag coromony in every school followed by a literary-musical program featuring families that have promoted solidarity by engaging in activities that enhance the artistic talents common among the members.
 - Conduct an essay writing contest on the thomes of Pather's Day and Mother's Day.
 - Encourage the Rabataang Barangay to undertake community projects paying tribute to parents.

- L. To highlight the observance of Father's Day and Nother's Day, schools may revive the tradition of school children wearing flowers of appropriate color, i.e. pink or red for non-orphans and white for exphans.
- 5. The cooperation of all achool officials and teachers in public and private schools is horeby enjoined to incure the success of the celebrations.
