COMPETITIVE EXAMINATION FOR THE PRESIDENT FERDINAND E. MARCOS
SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM FOR FISHERIES

1. An open competitive examination for the purpose of selecting scholars for the President Ferdinand E. Marcos Scholarship Program for Fisheries will be conducted on February 18, 1984 for 2½ hours. The examination will include test items in the Sciences (Biology, Chemistry and Geometry) and English (Grammar and Reading Comprehension, and Basic Fisheries) and Mathematics (Applied Arithmetic, Algebra and Geometry). It will be administered by the FEM Scholarship Program Secretariat assisted by a maximum of five (5) proctors designated by the NECS regional director in the following testing centers:

The NECSRO directors should immediately submit to this Office the exact venues where the tests will be conducted on or before December 12, 1983.

2. The results of this examination will be announced in April 1984, copy furnished the office of the provincial/city school superintendent through the MECS regional director.

3. The FEM Scholarship program for Fisheries provide for School Year 1984-1985 a maximum of 5 scholars per region for college studies leading to the degree of Bachelor of Science in Fisheries.

4. A scholar under this program will be entitled to: a) free matriculation and other school fees; b) back allowance of P250.00 per semester; c) monthly stipend of P700; and d) thesis support and graduation expenses.

5. High school graduates/graduating students who were certified by their respective school heads as among the TOP TEN (Not Upper 10%) in the graduating class to which they belong and not more than 20 yrs. old are eligible to take the competitive examination for the scholarship program. It is understood that the applicants are Filipino citizens, of good moral standing, physically fit, free from criminal, civil or administrative liability, and genuinely interested to pursue college studies in Fisheries.

6. Applicants for scholarship under this program should file their application on or before January 20, 1984 using the inclosed application form, through the Provincial/City/Division FEM Scholarship Screening Committee. The Committee shall be composed of the provincial/city school superintendent as Chairman, the Provincial Governor/City Mayor as Co-Chairman, and Assemblyman representing the province, the President of the Local Mayor's League and the BFAR Provincial Program Officer, as members. Application forms may be obtained from the office of the provincial/city schools superintendent.

7. The provincial/city schools superintendent shall forward the applications of qualified applicants, through the MECS Regional Director, to the FEM Scholarship Program Secretariat, Arcadia Bldg. Quezon Avenue, Q.C. on or before February 6, 1984.

8. It is desired that the contents of this Memorandum be immediately disseminated and given the widest publicity possible for the information and guidance of all concerned.
