5TH MECS-MACSO ANNUAL CONVENTION

To: Regional Directors  
Schools Superintendents  
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities  
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities  
Vocational School Superintendents/Administrators  
Principals, National/City/Provincial High Schools

1. The Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports National Association of Civil Security Officers (MECS-MACSO) will hold its 5th Annual Convention on March 21-23, 1984 at Laag National High School, Laag City. The theme for this year's convention is "The Filipino Ideology: Its Relevance to Nation Building."
2. This convention will mainly focus on the full operationalization of the Civil Security Units throughout the country geared towards national development. This will be highlighted with the awarding of certificates to the "Ten Outstanding Security Officers" of the MECS throughout the thirteen (13) regions.
3. Participants to this convention will include only those officially designated security officers whose names appear in the list submitted by the regional security officers in compliance with the request dated September 22, 1983. Security officers from the National Capital Region (NCR) may get in touch with the Chief, Research and Documentation Division, Bureau of Youth Affairs, Foreign Students and Foreign Schools, MECS, Manila.
4. A registration fee of P250 will be charged each participant to defray expenses on handouts, honoraria of resource speakers and other incidental expenses which may arise during the convention. Expenses incidental to their travel will be charged against local funds subject, however, to the usual accounting and auditing procedures. Those from the private schools will be paid from the funds of their respective schools.
5. For accommodation purposes, regional security officers are requested to submit to the Research and Documentation Division, Bureau of Youth Affairs, Foreign Students and Foreign Schools, this Ministry, the number of participants from their respective regions who will attend the said convention on or before February 29, 1984.







6. Dissemination of the contents of this Memorandum is desired.
