LAUNCHING THE KILUSANG SARILING SIKAP
IMPLEMENTING THE SELF-RELIANT HOME
CONSUMPTION MOVEMENT

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities
Vocational School Superintendents/Administrators

1. Pursuant to Letter of Instruction No. 1368, mobilizing all government networks, private organizations and individuals to implement the self-reliant home consumption movement as a multi-level and integrated approach toward making every family self-sufficient in times of crisis, the President and the First Lady launched nationwide on December 22, 1983 at the University of Life, the Kilusang Sariling Sikap.
2. Seven Kitchen Garden Technology areas, namely: Azolla propagation, Vermicomposting, Tilapia production, Herbal plants propagation, Vegetable production, Root crop production and fruit tree/forest tree propagation, have been identified to support the home production activities of every family home.
3. This Ministry in collaboration with the University of Life has been directed to establish regional as well as provincial training input centers to train trainers at the municipal level for technology transfer as well as to develop viable training programs and projects to serve every family home.
4. Along with this directive a series of workshops has been undertaken at the University of Life and at UPLB under the joint sponsorship of this Ministry and the Technology Resource Center of the NRS participated in by administrators of selected agricultural and fishery schools. Through these series of workshops, regional as well as provincial training input centers were identified. These regional and provincial centers and the directory of the trained trainers representing regional and provincial centers are found in the inclosure. These trained trainers can now be tapped to train prospective trainers in the municipal and at the barangay levels.

5. Considering the urgency of this program for the country's economy, the regional as well as the provincial centers shall spearhead the program and start the training of trainers in the municipal as well as in the barangay levels in their respective areas. Those schools who failed to send their specialist to the trainers course at the University of Ife should send the names of the specialists for the trainers course as soon as possible to the Technology Resource Center in Makati.
6. Regional directors and administrators of the regional and provincial centers in all regions shall take the lead in seeing to it that all schools under the umbrella of the provincial centers shall conduct the training of trainers as soon as possible and to pilot barangays within the service area of each school to implement the Seven Kitchen Garden Technology areas as soon as possible.
7. The MDS-KKK National Secretariat is responsible in the implementation of this program jointly with the Technology Resource Center of the MDS. All communications, reports and other requirements of the regional as well as the provincial centers should be addressed to the Project Manager, MDS-KKK National Secretariat, copy furnished the Technology Resource Center, Euxidia Ext., Makati, Metro Manila.
8. This Memorandum should be given the widest publicity possible.
